

Northwest Reined Cow Horse Association Non-Pro Beginning Boxing & Beginning Reining Rules

1. Rider may not have won more than \$100 at any horse show (NRCHA, NRHA, NCHA...) or accumulated 10 Breed Association points in any working horse event (reining, cutting, sorting, penning...).
2. In accordance with NRCHA \$5,000 Non-Pro Limited class, rider is not to have earned more than \$750 in "down the fence" classes to be eligible for the NWRCHA Beginning Boxing Class.
3. Eligibility will be determined as of January 1st of each year. This means that if you win a class(s) where your earnings will total \$100 or more during the 2019 show season, you will continue to be eligible for the NWRCHA Non-Pro Beginning Boxing and/or Beginning Reining class for the rest of the 2019 NWRCHA shows. You will not be eligible for the Beginning Boxing and/or Beginning Reining in 2019 or after.
4. The Beginning Boxing will be run concurrent with the NRCHA \$5,000 Non-Pro Limited and NRCHA Non Pro Limited class. A separate entry fee for each class applies.
5. A silver belt buckle will be awarded to the Non-Pro winner of the Beginning Boxing class on Sunday afternoon after the final class of the day has been completed or an earlier time will be announced. To be eligible to win the buckle, you must compete in both the Saturday and Sunday Beginning Boxing class. ***If you win a buckle at a 2019 show, you may still compete in the Beginning Boxing class but you WILL NOT be eligible to win a 2nd buckle. In such a case, the buckle would be awarded to the high-scoring non-buckle winning horse/rider.***
6. When the NWRCHA Beginning Reining class is offered, riders will sign-up in the corresponding AQHA Reining class for which they are eligible (i.e. Youth Beginning reiners will ride concurrent with the AQHA Novice Youth class).
7. Year-End Awards may or may not be offered as club funds allow for the Beginning Boxing class. NO Year-End Awards will be offered for the Beginning Reining class.
8. Membership with the NWRCHA is not required to show in the Beginning Boxing and/or Beginning Reining.
9. Chaps are not required to show in either the Beginning Boxing or Beginning Reining classes. A long sleeve shirt and western hat are required.
10. Rider may use any NRCHA approved bit and may choose to ride one or two-handed regardless of bit choice.
11. Rider may cross-enter with other AQHA, NRCHA and/or NWRCHA classes at our shows. Rule #3 (see above) will still apply for any monies won. NRCHA and AQHA rules will prevail for cross-entries.
